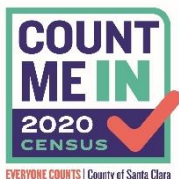

Before you apply, here is what you will need to complete the online application:

- Social Security Number:** You cannot apply without a Social Security number. It will serve as your unique identifier. Visit the Social Security Administration website (www.ssa.gov) or contact your local SSA office for more information. To find the nearest office, visit: <https://secure.ssa.gov/ICON/ic001.do>
- E-mail Address:** The Census Bureau will communicate with candidates via e-mail. If you do not have an e-mail address, you can obtain one for free from providers such as Yahoo! Mail, Google Mail, Hotmail, etc.
- Valid Driver's License**
- Selective Service.** Be registered with the Selective Service System or have a qualifying exemption, if you are a male born after Dec. 31, 1959. To register or verify selective service registration, call (847) 688-6888 or visit www.sss.gov/ For answers to frequently asked questions, visit www.sss.gov/QA
- Veterans Preference.** Veterans who would like to claim veterans' preference will need supporting documentation, such as a copy of their DD-214: Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty, or other acceptable documentation. Applicants claiming 10-point preference will need to submit Form SF-15. If you need assistance, call or visit:
