# Know Your Rights Resources

Everyone in the United States, regardless of their immigration status, has fundamental rights and protections under the U.S. Constitution that they can exercise, including the right to remain silent, keep their door closed, and right to speak to a lawyer. These rights can be expressed non-verbally with a red card.

## Usted tiene derechos constitucionales:

- **NO ABRA LA PUERTA** si un agente de inmigración está tocando la puerta.
- **NO CONTESTE NINGUNA PREGUNTA** de un agente de inmigración si el trata de hablar con usted. Usted tiene el derecho de mantenerse callado.
- **NO FIRME NADA** sin antes hablar con un abogado. Usted tiene el derecho de hablar con un abogado.
- Si usted está afuera de su casa, pregunte al agente si es libre para irse y si dice que sí, váyase con tranquilidad.
- **ENTREGUE ESTA TARJETA AL AGENTE.** Si usted está dentro de su casa, muestre la tarjeta por la ventana o pásela debajo de la puerta.

I do not wish to speak with you, answer your questions, or sign or hand you any documents based on my 5th Amendment rights under the United States Constitution.

I do not give you permission to enter my home based on my 4th Amendment rights under the United States Constitution unless you have a warrant to enter, signed by a judge or magistrate with my name on it that you slide under the door.

I do not give you permission to search any of my belongings based on my 4th Amendment rights.

I choose to exercise my constitutional rights.

These cards are available to citizens and noncitizens alike.

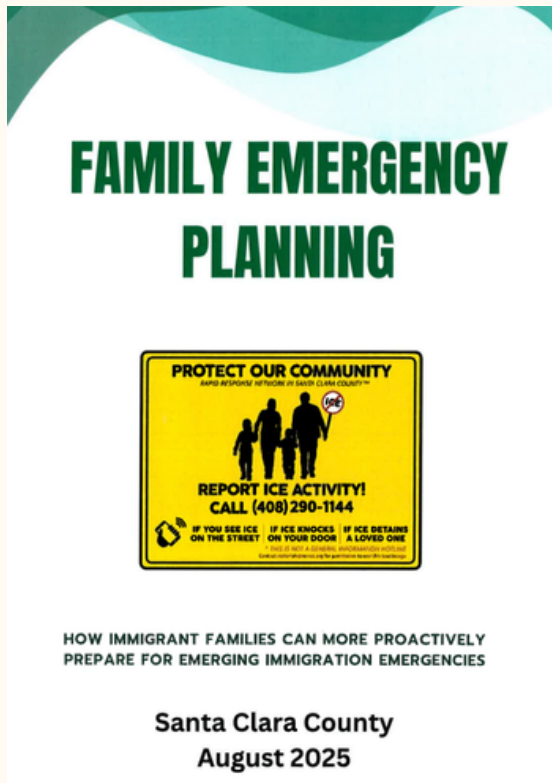

# Childcare Safety Plan

The Childcare Safety Plan is an important document that outlines parents' wishes in the event the parent is unavailable to care for their child. The plan includes designation of temporary caregiver, children information, and optional international travel. This is a free document and should not cost money.



## Santa Clara County Family Emergency Planning Guide

This packet allows families in Santa Clara County to assign a temporary caregiver in case of detention, deportation, or another emergency that may separate a family. In the plan, families can organize important documents, such as passports, birth certificates, medical information, and emergency contacts.

# Public Charge & Public Benefits

Late last Friday, September 5, 2025, USCIS issued a policy memo to USCIS officers related to public charge. The Protecting Immigrant Families Coalition has drafted an explainer that provides more information about the memo, but the key takeaways are:

1. It does not change the benefits considered in a public charge test.
2. The Biden public charge rule is still in place.
3. Public charge policy has not changed.

*\*This public charge information holds true as of 3/24/2026.*
